#### Tomorrow is Deadline for PRE-ACT Sign-up!

If you tried the link in last week's announcement and discovered it was not working, try again. The PreACT is an annual multiplechoice test over English, math, reading, and science, designed to give 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grade students valuable preparation for the actual ACT. The ACT is an entrance exam used by most colleges in the U.S. to make admissions decisions. Parents often spend hundreds of dollars on ACT prep for their students because of the difference a few points on a composite score can make on scholarships. Results from the PreACT are a good predictor of how students will do on the ACT. The PreACT (online for the first time this year) takes 2 hours and 30 minutes to administer, and the test environment is set up as similar as possible to the ACT test environment. If you are in 8th-10th grade, please take advantage of this opportunity and sign up below to take the test November 13.
