PRE-ACT DATE SET FOR FRIDAY, NOV. 14

Students at Shekinah have the option to take the PreACT, which is an annual multiple-choice test over English, math, reading, and science, designed to give students valuable preparation for the actual ACT. This test is for 9th and 10th grade students, but 8th graders are also welcome to take it to prepare for the ACT. The ACT is an entrance exam used by most colleges in the U.S. to make admissions decisions. Parents often spend hundreds of dollars on ACT prep for their students because of the difference a few points on a composite score can make on scholarships. Results from the Pre-ACT are a good predictor of how students will do on the ACT. The Pre-ACT (online again this year) takes 2 hours and 30 minutes to administer, and the test environment is set up as similar as possible to the ACT test environment. If you are in 8th-10th grade, please take advantage of this opportunity and sign up below by Friday, Nov. 7.
